Wax Seals:

- Q1) How quick do you need it?
- A1) Many companies offer custom wax seals but send you a blank seal in a nice presentation box only for you to have to send of a voucher to have you seal engraved, this process can take upto to 3 weeks.

 Ours are made inhouse and can be despatched guaranteed next day.
- Q2) Do you also make seals from customers own artwork?
- A2) Yes, its our speciality, we can either machine hand engrave or produce the seal literally by hand using little chisels and can produce 3D effect seals.
- Q3) What are your seals made of?
- A3) Solid brass, some companies offer resin or plated brass seals
- Q4) Do your online prices include VAT & P&P Worldwide?
- A4) Yes they include vat & standard delivery, be careful on other sites as these may not be added till you get to the checkout.
- Q5) Why don't you offer fancy presentation boxes?
- A5) To keep the costs down, thats why we are the cheapest online for custom seals. From customer feedback, they would rather have a varied choice & quick service than a fancy box.
- Q6) Small or Large?
- A6) A few companies offer small & large seals, please bear in mind that our 'small' is roughly the same size as there 'large' seal. our small is 25mm & large 38mm
- Q7) Where do the component parts for the seal originate from?
- A7) All the bits are made exclusively in the UK, from wooden handle to brass head to actual engraving of your seal.

 Most of the 'fancy' boxed items are bought in from china or similar. I say buy 'British' !!!!
- Q8) Who to buy from?
- A8) We all know the internet has been great for buying wax seals, as you have a lot of choice. It just depends on whether you want a mass produced one initial seal which other websites sell very cheaply or a personalised seal with a varied choice, ie typestyles & layouts

Sealing Wax:.

- Q1) What kind of sealing wax do you sell?
- A1) We offer 2 kinds, traditional wax which is like a candle where you light the wick and drip it on the letter and then stamp your seal into or our glue gun wax which is perfect if higher volumes of impressions are needed, you basically plug in the glue gun, squeeze out the wax and stamp your seal into.

- Q2) Why does your wax only make 4-8 impresssions per stick and othe websites quote 16-20?
- A2) Because there quoting seals that have a small diameter like 16mm, whereas ours are the 'normal' 25mm size, we are also much more realistic with our quotes.
- Q3) Can i have some sealing wax by next day guaranteed?
- A3) Next day delivery is fine on all orders as i stock them in large quantities.
